The Cadillac 75 Convertible Coupe by Fleetwood is a 2 door 4 seater Luxury Car Convertible / Cabriolet style automobile with a Front, Longitudinally Mounted engine powering the rear wheels. The power is produced by Engine Type GM Cadillac V-8 331 , this powerplant features Single overhead valve (OHV), Naturally Aspirated engine with 2 valves per cylinder, 16 valves in total and a displacement of 5.7 litres capacity. The Cadillac 75 Convertible Coupe by Fleetwood has an output of 137,4 bhp / 139,4 PS / 1104 kW @ 5,000 rpm of power, and maximum torque of TBA Nm / TBA ft lbs @ 0,000 rpm. The engine drives the wheels via 3 Speed Manual Synchronesh transmission. The Cadillac 75 Convertible Coupe by Fleetwood Quoted kerb weight is 2.200 kg / 4.800 lbs. Estimated Top speed is 188 km/h (117 mph) and is said to be able to manage 0-100 km/h // 0- 62 mph in 16,2 secs.
