CATALOGUE ESSAY

The Ferrari 212 Inter Coupe by Vignale is a 2 door 2 seater Grand Tourer Coupe style automobile with a Front, Longitudinally Mounted engine powering the Rear Wheels designed by Giovanni Michelotti for Vignale. The power is produced by Engine Type Ferrari Colombo V-12 , this powerplant features Single overhead camshaft (SOHC), Naturally Aspirated engine with 2 valves per cylinder, 24 valves in total and a displacement of 2.5 litres capacity. The Ferrari 212 Inter Coupe by Vignale has an output of 168 bhp / 170 PS / 130 kW @ 6,500 rpm of power, and maximum torque of 164 Nm / 121 ft lbs @ 5,000 rpm. The engine drives the wheels via 5 Speed Manual Transmission. The Ferrari 212 Inter Coupe by Vignale Quoted kerb weight is 1,000 kg / 2,205 lbs. Estimated Top speed is 180 km/h (112 mph) and is said to be able to manage 0-100 km/h // 0- 62 mph in 9,4 secs.
