The Bugatti Type 13 Brescia by Maron-Pot et Cie is a 0 door 2 seater Convertible / Cabriolet style automobile with a Front, Longitudinally Mounted engine powering the rear wheels. The power is produced by Engine Type Straight 4, Dry Sump Lubrication, This powerplant features Dual overhead camshaft (DOHC), Naturally Aspirated engine with 2 valves per cylinder, 16 valves in total and a displacement of 1.5 litres capacity. The Bugatti Type 13 Brescia by Maron-Pot et Cie has an output of 20 bhp / 20 PS / 15 kW @ 4.300 rpm of power, and maximum torque of TBA Nm / TBA ft lbs @ 0,000 rpm. The engine drives the wheels via 4 Speed Manual Transmission. The Bugatti Type 13 Brescia by Maron-Pot et Cie kerb weight is 300 kilo / 661 lbs. Estimated Top speed is 100 km/h (62 mph) and is said to be able to manage 0-100 km/h // 0- 62 mph in 15 secs.
