CATALOGUE ESSAY

The The McLaren 720S N-Largo by Novitec is a 2 seater fixed-head coupé with 2 doors and a mid mounted engine which delivers the power through the rear wheels. It is powered by a turbocharged engine of 4 litre capacity. This unit features double overhead camshaft valve gear, a 90 degree V 8 cylinder layout, and 4 valves per cylinder. It produces 795 bhp / 806 PS / 601 kW of power at 7500 rpm, and maximum torque of 878 Nm / 647 ft lbs at 5500 rpm. This power is delivered to the wheels via a 7 speed automatic transmission. The McLaren 720S N-Largo by Novitec weighs a quoted 1419 kg at the kerb. Maximum speed quoted is 346 km/h (215 mph), officially stated fuel consumption figures are 15.8/7.9/10.7 l/100km urban/extra-urban/combined, and carbon dioxide emissions are 249.0 g/km.

- The car can been lowered 1.3 inches with sport springs, and it sits on staggered Vossen MC2 forged center-lock wheels, 20-inch in the front and 21-inch in the rear, wrapped in Pirelli P-Zero rubber.
- Significantly wider body (+60 mm / 2.36 inches at the front and +130 mm / 5.1 inches at the rear) complemented by a custom suspension lowering the ride height by 35 mm (1.38 inches).
- As for the twin-turbo 4.0-liter V8 engine, it has been massaged to 795 horsepower and a
 massive 878 Newton-meters (648 pound-feet) of torque. is reflected in the car's performance,
 with the sprint to 62 mph (100 kph) taking just 2.7 seconds or two tenths of a second less than
 the stock car.
- Perhaps more impressive is the fact that Novitec has shaved off three tenths of a second from the 0-124 mph (0-200 kph) sprint, which is now done in just 7.5 seconds.
- Flat out, it will do 215 mph (346 kph) or slightly more than the regular model.
